Orbus Centre Update:

The Orbus Kindy and Junior Primary School for OVC:

Changes have been made regarding the oversight of the Orbus Centre in Malawi, with the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian (CCAP) Blantyre Synod transferring the responsibility for the Centre internally from their BSHDC division to their schools division, the Synod Education Office, which has a large number of schools under supervision in southern Malawi.

The Education Office recently visited the Orbus School and reported that "Impressive teaching and learning activities are taking place. Checking of students work revealed that teachers are dedicated." Enrolments are as follows:

The Orbus Farm:

The farm has performed reasonably well during the period. There are currently approximately 43 pigs and piglets, 6 goats after recent sales, and 200 chickens. The period saw Orbus' best maize crop produced which has now been harvested. Pumpkin, Chinese cabbage, onion and sweet potatoes have also been grown. Some fruit trees are growing well with some guava fruit nearly ready for harvest. The farm manager, Lameck has recently completed a three day course on "Farming God's way."











Site Improvements/developments:









General improvements at the Orbus Centre during the period include: Electricity has been connected; 30 new desks have been organized; solar powered security systems, special alarm and security lighting systems controlled by remote controls have been installed; steel security door protectors have been fitted; solar power has now been installed on the Calvin Building, with two very good floodlights lighting the pig shed, goat and chicken sheds; and arrangements have been made with the Malawi police force to have two policemen and their families living on the Orbus property, in the Martyn Lloyd-Jones building apartments. Orbus will provide this accommodation rent free in return for their presence, which it is hoped will act to increase security and protect resources, livestock and crops. The first policeman has already moved in.









Additional improvements during the quarter include general maintenance; the refurbishment of the chicken shed; providing additional toilets; fitting skylights in the Spurgeon classroom building to allow in more light; fixing the irrigation system; dividing the Standard 1 classroom into two new classrooms, and repairing the Augustine well pump. Extra activities at the Centre have included women's craft classes; and re-starting the porridge feeding program which ceased for a few weeks during and after the January holiday period.
